God is WITH us, God is FOR us

God is with us

- 'The LORD replied, "My presence will go with you and I will give you rest.'" (Exodus 33:14)
- 'God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.' (Psalm 46:1)
- '...Then Jesus said... "Surely I am with you always to the very end of the age.'" (Matthew 28:18-20)

God is for us

- 'The LORD will fight for you...' (Exodus 14:14)
- 'Do not be afraid of them; the LORD your God himself will fight for you.' (Deuteronomy 3:22)
- God is for us, so we are more than conquerors (Romans 8:31-38)

Verse 1

- David faced Goliath (1 Samuel 17:1-52)
- Daniel faced the lions (Daniel 6:16-24)
- Ruth faced a foreign land (Ruth 1:1-22)
- Esther faced extinction (Esther chapters 2&3: 'ethnic cleansing' plot to destroy the Jewish race, when Esther, the beautiful orphaned Jewess, was the Queen of the Persian King Xerxes)

Verse 2

- Moses faced the Red Sea (Exodus 14:13-end)
- Noah faced the flood (Genesis 6:13, chapters 7&8)
- Joshua faced big battles (e.g. Jericho: Joshua 6:1-21, Ai: Joshua 8:1-23)
- Mary faced disgrace (Matthew 1:18-end: Mary became pregnant whilst betrothed to Joseph who was not the father; an unmarried mother)
